AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PLANNED UNIT DEVELOPMENT FOR THE PROSPECT CROSSING SHOPPING PLAZA AT 1219-1297 NORTH RAND ROAD AND APPROVING A SPECIAL USE PERMIT FOR AN ELECTRONIC MESSAGE CENTER

WHEREAS, on November 17, 1988, the City of Prospect Heights approved a Planned Unit Development (hereinafter "PUD") for a commercial shopping plaza at 1219-1297 N. Rand Road, commonly known as Prospect Crossing (hereinafter "Property"), by adoption of Ordinance O-88-36; and

WHEREAS, the PUD originally included approved plans for two free-standing ground signs plus wall signs for each tenant space; and

WHEREAS, the PUD originally included an approved site plan for the Property; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has amended the PUD from time to time upon the petition of the owners or tenants at the Property; and

WHEREAS, on January 8, 2007, the City Council adopted Ordinance O-07-01 which amended the PUD to allow a third ground sign at the Property; and

WHEREAS, Tony's Fresh Market (hereinafter "Petitioner"), 1241 N. Rand Road, with the consent of the owners of the Property, filed a petition to amend the PUD so that Petitioner may replace the existing, third free-standing ground sign with a new larger free standing ground sign that contains an electronic message center ("Proposed Sign"); and

WHEREAS, as part of its petition, Petitioner has requested exceptions to the height and area requirements for ground signs as the Proposed Sign is ten feet (10') higher than the maximum permitted fifteen feet (15') and has a sign area forty square feet (40 sq.ft.) larger than the maximum permitted one hundred square feet (100 sq.ft.), in accord with the plans submitted at the public hearing on the petitions (the "Exceptions"); and

WHEREAS, the Petitioner also filed a petition for a Special Use Permit for an electronic message center; and

WHEREAS, the Plan/Zoning Board of Appeals has found the petitions meet the standards for a PUD and the standards for a Special Use and has recommended that the City Council approve the amendment to the PUD with the Exceptions and the Special Use; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council have reviewed the documents pertinent to the application and the recommendations of the Plan/Zoning Board of Appeals and determined that the standards for a PUD and Special Use have been met;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PROSPECT HEIGHTS, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS as follows:

<u>Section 1.</u> The City Council hereby finds and determines that the facts set forth in the preamble hereto are true and correct and hereby incorporates same as part of this Ordinance.

Section 2. That the report and recommendation of the PZBA is concurred in and the Petitioner's application for an amendment to the PUD with Exceptions and for a special use permit to allow an electronic message board is hereby granted.

Section 3. Ordinance O-88-36 approving a Planned Unit Development for the property located at 1219-1297 North Rand Road, legally described in Exhibit A, as amended, is hereby further amended to permit the replacement of the third free-standing ground sign with a new larger ground sign which contains an electronic message center, substantially as depicted on the plans presented at the public hearing.

<u>Section 4.</u> The Special Use permit is hereby granted for the electronic message center in accordance with Section 5-9-5A of the Zoning Code.

<u>Section 5.</u> The amendment to the PUD and the Special Use permit are subject to the following additional conditions:

- 1. The Petitioner shall submit a complete landscape plan for the review and approval of the Director of Building and Zoning which shows the area to be landscaped, the types and quantities of the plants being proposed, and a maintenance plan for the landscaped area along the Route 12 frontage.
- 2. The electronic message center shall not be operated while Tony's Finer Foods is closed and the lights illuminating the panel portion of the free standing ground sign shall be dimmed when Tony's Finer Foods is closed.
- 3. The property owner will work with the City staff to notify the existing tenants of the shopping center about the City's temporary sign requirements to improve compliance with the temporary sign provisions of the City Code.

Section 6. This Ordinance and all exhibits attached hereto shall be recorded at the Cook County Recorder of Deeds at the expense of the Petitioner, and the amendment to the PUD shall run with the land.

Section 7.	This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as

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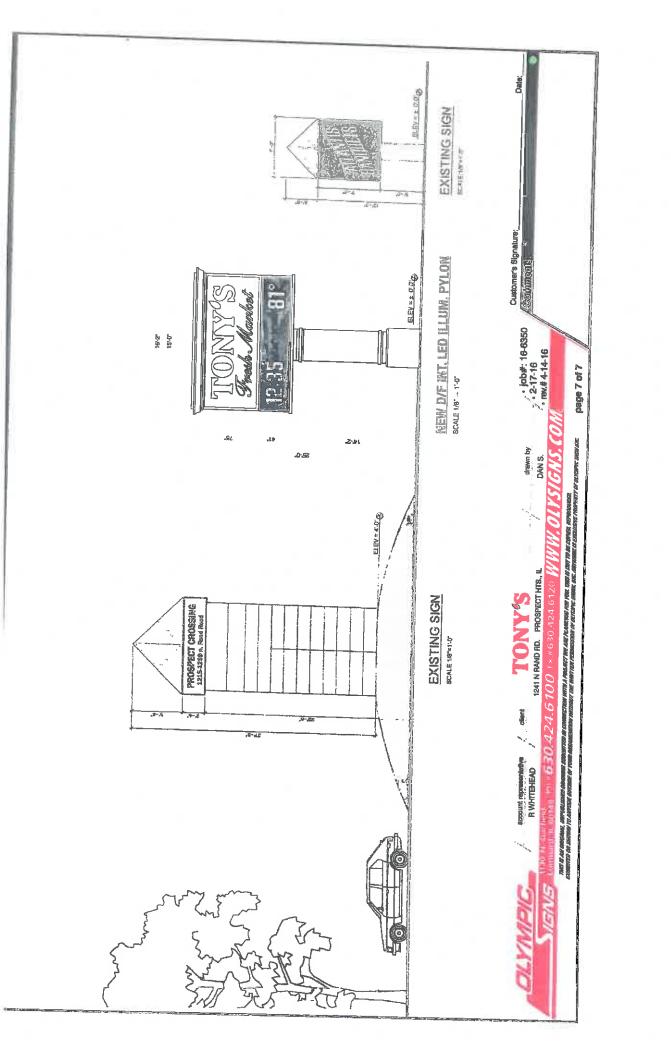

Request:

The petitioner is seeking an amendment to Ordinance #O-07-01 to allow for the construction of a variation to Section 5-9-3B1g to allow a replacement free standing 162.5 sq. ft., 25 ft. high pylon sign up to the front property line. Also to consider a Special Use Permit for an electronic message sign per Section 5-9-5A.

Standards for Amendment of Planned Unit Development:

- A. Any substantial change in character of any existing planned unit development shall require the adoption of an ordinance which shall make such changes and modifications in said planned unit development as may be approved by the mayor and city council.
 - 1. Said amendatory ordinance may be adopted only after a public hearing by and recommendation of the plan/zoning board of appeals in like manner as is required herein for the adoption of an original planned unit development ordinance.

Response: A hearing is required as the request for the new replacement pylon sign in the same location is proposing an increase in sign area and sign height:

Area: Proposed 162.5 sq. ft.

Maximum per Code: 100 sq. ft. permitted.

Height:

Proposed 25'

Existing: 18' per Ordinance #O-07-01

Standards for Special Uses:

The following signs may be allowed by special use permit issued by the plan/zoning board of appeals in accordance with the provisions of section 5-10-9, "Special Use Permits", of this title. (Ord., 7-1989; amd. Ord. 0-03-35, 9-15-2003)

A. Electronic Message Centers:

- 1. The electronic message center shall serve the public convenience at that location and shall be located no closer than five hundred feet (500') to another such sign directed to the same street.
- 2. The electronic message center shall be designed and located such that the entire sign message will be legible to the motorists viewing the sign.
- 3. The sign structure shall conform to all applicable regulations as specified in this chapter.
- 4. The sign message shall not consist of flashing, scintillating, chasing or animated lights, and shall not change more frequently than once every two (2) seconds.
- E. Standards: No special use shall be recommended by the plan/zoning board of appeals unless said board shall find: (Ord. 0-77-27, 7-18-1977; amd. Ord. 0-03-35, 9-15-2003)
 - 1. That the establishment, maintenance or operation of the special use will not be unreasonably detrimental to or endanger the public health, safety, morals, comfort or general welfare.

Response: Standard is met for the electronic message sign.

2. That the special use will not be injurious to the use and enjoyment of other property in the community for the purposes already permitted, nor diminish and impair property values within the community.

Response: Standard is met.

3. That the establishment of the special use will not impede the normal and orderly development and improvement of surrounding property for uses permitted in the district.

4. That adequate utilities, access roads, drainage and/or other necessary facilities have been or are being provided.

Response: There is an existing pylon sign that has electrical power to the area. Standard is met.

5. That adequate measures have been or will be taken to provide ingress or egress so designed to minimize traffic congestion in the public streets. (Ord. 0-77-27, 7-18-1977)

Response: Replacing existing sign. Standard is met

6. That the special use shall, in all other respects, conform to the applicable regulations of the district in which it is located, except as such regulations may in each instance be modified by the city council pursuant to the recommendations of the plan/zoning board of appeals. (Ord. 0-77-27, 7-18-1977; amd. Ord. 0-03-35, 9-15-2003)

Response: Standard is met.

7. That the area described in the petition does not lie wholly or partly in floodplain, as defined by the flood control ordinances of the city; or, if it does lie wholly or partly within the floodplain, that adequate provisions for storage, runoff control and floodwater retention, as appropriate, have been made.

Response: Not Applicable as this is a replacement being placed in the exact location as previous sign. Standard met.

Conclusion

Staff has reviewed the signage plan for the new tenant Tony's Fresh Market and has determined that the application for the proposed amendment and special are in conformance with the standards of the City of Prospect Heights Zoning Code.

Staff concurs with the request.

Variation to Reduce Required Side Yard Setback for an Addition to a Legal Non-

Conforming Garage.

Issue: Matt & Lyndy Zimmer, owners of the subject property, are seeking a variation to Section 5-6-1 E2 of the City of Prospect Heights Zoning Code to allow the reduction of the required setback from 15' to 10.35' for the construction of a minor addition to their garage which is an existing legal non-conforming structure.

Background: The PZBA held a public hearing on March 24, 2016 and continued until April 21, 2016 for proper service. The existing home was constructed in the 1950's and was built with a 10.65' side yard setback. The proposed addition will be in conformance with the existing building line and not encroach any further into the side yard. The PZBA voted unanimously to recommend approval of the variation.

Applicants have requested a waiver of first reading and staff concurs.

Recommendation: Approve the waiver of first reading and Approve Ordinance No. O-16-17 Granting Certain Variations.

ORDINANCE NO. 0-16-17

AN ORDINANCE GRANTING CERTAIN VARIATIONS FOR THE PROPERTY AT 420 CLARENDON PROSPECT HEIGHTS, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, the provisions of the Prospect Heights Zoning Ordinance applicable to the property legally described in Exhibit A attached hereto (hereinafter "Property") and commonly known as 420 W. Clarendon St. prescribe that the principal structure maintain a 15' side yard setback from the property line, and

WHEREAS, the owner of the Property has submitted for consideration of a variation to allow a 4.35' reduction in the side yard setback for an addition to a single family residence from 15' to 10' to match the existing legal non-conforming structure per Section 5-6-1E2 of the City of Prospect Heights Zoning Code on the property commonly known as 420 W. Clarendon St., Prospect Heights, Illinois, in the City's R-1 Single Family Residential District; and

WHEREAS, the Plan/Zoning Board of Appeals held a public hearing on April 21, 2016 regarding said application; and

WHEREAS, the Plan/Zoning Board of Appeals has recommended the Requested Variation be approved and has made the necessary finding therefore; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council have reviewed the recommendation of the Plan/Zoning Board of Appeals;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PROSPECT HEIGHTS, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS as follows:

Section 1. The City Council hereby finds and determines that the facts set forth in the preamble hereto are true and correct and hereby incorporates them as part of this Ordinance.

Section 2. The Requested Variation is hereby granted.

Section 3. That this variation is conditioned upon applicant's construction of the addition substantially in accordance with the approved plans and documents submitted at the public hearing on this matter and with applicable codes.

Section 4. That this Ordinance and all exhibits attached hereto shall be recorded at the Cook County Recorder's Office at the expense of the Owners.

<u>Section 5.</u> The City Clerk is directed to publish this ordinance in pamphlet form and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as required by law.

ORDINANCE NO. O-16-11

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISING A CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM FOR THE CITY OF PROSPECT HEIGHTS, ILLINOIS

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PROSPECT HEIGHTS, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

SECTION ONE: A Capital Improvement Program is hereby established as a means of planning for required improvement to the infrastructure of the City of Prospect Heights and reserving funds for those improvements.

SECTION TWO: That the fiscal 2016-2017 Capital Improvement Program ("CIP") for the City of Prospect Heights, Illinois is attached and incorporated into this ordinance as Exhibit A is hereby adopted and approved.

SECTION THREE: The Capital Improvement Program shall be a guideline for the budgeting and expenditure of funds for capital improvements of the City of Prospect Heights during the above stated fiscal year, but shall not create an entitlement for any person or entity to have a particular improvement or obligate the City to expend any money.

SECTION FOUR: The funds set forth in the attached CIP shall be deemed assigned for the corresponding projects and shall be deemed assigned for the corresponding projects and shall not be used for other purposes without subsequent amendment to this ordinance by the City Council.

SECTION FIVE: That the City Clerk of the City of Prospect Heights is directed to publish this Ordinance in pamphlet from and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication.

Re: Passport Parking

The City has been in the process of reviewing various parking fines and penalties. Attached are sections which we feel need immediate revisions.

The City has changed the sections to reflect current penalties which are consistent with other sections of the City Code and reflect fines and penalties which are sufficiently punitive to hinder future violations.

Staff recommends passage of the Ordinance.

ORDINANCE NO. 0-16-19

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING VARIOUS SECTIONS OF THE CITY CODE RELATED TO TITLE 9 POLICE REGULATIONS AND TITLE 10 MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC AS IT RELATES TO PENALTIES, VIOLATIONS AND FINES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PROSPECT HEIGHTS, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE: Title 9, Chapter 1, Section 4 B (4). ANIMALS AT LARGE; STRAYS Violations is hereby amended as follows:

9-1-4-B. Violations; Penalty: Any person violating any provision of this subsection B shall be fined not less than twenty five dollars (\$25.00) seventy five dollars (\$75.00) not more than twenty five dollars (\$25.00) five hundred dollars (\$500.00) for each offense. Any person cited under the provisions of this subsection B4 not paying the fine within ten (10) days shall face an additional penalty of twenty five dollars (\$25.00) not less than seventy five dollars (\$75.00) and not more than (\$500.00). (Ord. 0-97-78, 12-15-1997, eff. 1-1-1998)

SECTION TWO: Title 9, Chapter 1, Section 7 B. RABIES INOCULATON REQUIRED: Violations is hereby amended as follows:

9-1-7-B. Violations; Penalty: Any person violating any provision of this section shall be fined not less than twenty five dollars (\$25.00) seventy five dollars (\$75.00) not more than twenty five dollars (\$25.00) five hundred dollars (\$500.00) for each offense. Any person cited under the provisions of this section not paying the fine within ten (10) days shall face an additional penalty of twenty five dollars (\$25.00) not less than seventy five dollars (\$75.00) and not more than (\$500.00). (Ord. 0-97-79, 12-15-1997, eff. 1-1-1998)

SECTION THREE: Title 10, Chapter 7, Section 42 C. SKATEBOARDS PROHIBITED: Penalty is hereby amended as follows:

10-7-42-C. Penalty: Any person violating any provision of this section shall be fined no less than twenty five dollars (\$25.00) seventy five dollars (\$75.00) not more than twenty five dollars (\$25.00) five hundred dollars (\$500.00) for each offense and a separate offense shall be deemed committed on each day during or on which a violation occurs or continues. Any person cited under the provisions of this section not paying the fine within ten (10) days shall face an additional penalty of not less than seventy five dollars (\$75.00) and not more than (\$500.00). (Ord. 0-98-01, 1-20-1998, eff. 1-30-1998)

SECTION FOUR: Title 10, Chapter 7, Section 43 C. LOITERING: Penalty is hereby amended as follows:

10-7-43-C. Penalty: Any person violating any provision of this section shall be fined not less than twenty five dollars (\$25.00) seventy five dollars (\$75.00) not more than twenty five dollars (\$25.00) five hundred dollars (\$500.00) for each offense and a separate offense shall be deemed committed on each day during or on which a violation occurs or continues. Any person cited under the provisions of this section not paying the fine within ten (10) days shall face an additional penalty of not less than seventy five dollars (\$75.00) and not more than (\$500.00). (Ord. 0-98-02, 1-20-1998, eff. 1-30-1998)

SECTION FIVE: Title 10, Chapter 8, Section 1 A, B, E & J. NO PARKING PLACES: Violations is hereby amended as follows:

10-8-1-A. It shall be unlawful for any vehicle to stand in an intersection, except when necessary to avoid conflict with other traffic or in compliance with the directions of a police officer or traffic control device. Any person violating the provision of this subsection shall be fined not less than twenty five dollars (\$25.00) seventy five dollars (\$75.00) not more than twenty five dollars (\$25.00) five hundred dollars (\$500.00) for each offense. Failure to pay this fine within ten (10) days shall result in an additional penalty of twenty five dollars (\$25.00) not less than seventy five dollars (\$75.00) and not more than (\$500.00). (Ord. 0-97-86, 12-15-1997, eff. 1-1-1998)

10-8-1-B. It shall be unlawful for any vehicle to stand in a crosswalk, except when necessary to avoid conflict with other traffic or in compliance with the directions of a police officer or traffic control device. Any person violating the provision of this subsection shall be fined not less twenty five dollars (\$25.00) seventy five dollars (\$75.00) not more than twenty five dollars (\$25.00) five hundred dollars (\$500.00) for each offense. Failure to pay this fine within ten (10) days shall result in an additional penalty of twenty five dollars (\$25.00) not less than seventy five dollars (\$75.00) and not more than (\$500.00). (Ord. 0-97-87, 12-15-1997, eff. 1-1-1998)

10-8-1-E. It shall be unlawful for any vehicle to stand within thirty feet (30') of a traffic signal on the approaching side, except when necessary to avoid conflict with other traffic or in compliance with the directions of a police officer or traffic control device. Any person violating the provision of this subsection shall be fined not less than twenty five dollars (\$25.00) seventy five dollars (\$75.00) not more than twenty five dollars (\$25.00) five hundred dollars (\$500.00) for each offense. Failure to pay this fine within ten (10) days shall result in an additional penalty of twenty five dollars (\$25.00) not less than seventy five dollars (\$75.00) and not more than (\$500.00). (Ord. 0-97-88, 12-15-1997, eff. 1-1-1998)

10-8-1-J. It shall be unlawful for any vehicle to stand either along side or opposite any street excavation or obstruction when such parking would obstruct traffic, except when necessary to avoid conflict with other traffic or in compliance with

the directions of a police officer or traffic control device. Any person violating the provision of this subsection shall be fined not less than twenty five dollars (\$25.00) seventy five dollars (\$75.00) not more than twenty five dollars (\$25.00) five hundred dollars (\$500.00) for each offense. Failure to pay this fine within ten (10) days shall result in an additional penalty of twenty five dollars (\$25.00) not less than seventy five dollars (\$75.00) and not more than (\$500.00). (Ord. 0-97-89, 12-15-1997, eff. 1-1-1998)

SECTION SIX: Title 10, Chapter 8, Section 5. ALL NIGHT PARKING: Violations is hereby amended as follows:

10-8-5: ALL NIGHT PARKING:

In the single-family residential districts, it shall be unlawful for any person to park a vehicle between the hours of two o'clock (2:00) A.M. and six o'clock (6:00) A.M. of any day on any street, except for emergency purposes. In all of the districts, it shall be unlawful for any person to park a vehicle weighing in excess of eight thousand (8,000) pounds on any street for a period of time longer than thirty (30) minutes between the hours of two o'clock (2:00) A.M. and six o'clock (6:00) A.M. of any day, except for emergency purposes.

Any person violating the provision of this subsection shall be fined not less than twenty five dollars (\$25.00) seventy five dollars (\$75.00) not more than twenty five dollars (\$25.00) five hundred dollars (\$500.00) for each offense; and a separate offense shall be deemed committed on each day during or on which a violation occurs or continues.

Any person cited under the provisions of this section not paying the fine within ten (10) days shall face an additional penalty of twenty five dollars (\$25.00) not less than seventy five dollars (\$75.00) and not more than (\$500.00). (Ord. 0-97-81, 12-15-1997, eff. 1-1-1998)

SECTION SEVEN: Title 10, Chapter 8, Section 12. METRA COMMUTER STATION REGULATIONS: Fines and Penalties is hereby amended as follows:

10-8-12- E. Fines And Penalties: It shall be the duty of police officers of this city to report to the police department:

- 1. The state license number of any vehicle that has been parked in violation to the contrary of any of the provisions of this section;
- 2. The time such vehicle parked in violation of any of the provisions of this section;
- 3. Such other information as may be necessary for a thorough understanding of the circumstances attending such violation; and

4. Penalty for failures to pay required fee will be twenty dollars (\$20.00) seventy five dollars if paid within ten (10) days from the date of violation, and forty dollars (\$40.00) one hundred and fifty ((\$150.00) if more than ten (10) days from the date of the violation.

SECTION EIGHT: Title 10, Chapter 12, Section 4 PARKING VIOLATIONS is hereby deleted in its entirety:

10-12-4: PARKING VIOLATIONS:

Any person accused of violation of any provision of this title or other ordinance of the city prohibiting parking a vehicle in a designated area or restricting the length of time the vehicle may be there parked, may settle and compromise the claim against him or her for such illegal parking by paying to the city the sum of ten dollars (\$10.00) within forty eight (48) hours of the time such alleged offense was committed. Such payment may be made at the city hall, and a receipt shall be issued for all money so received, and such money shall be promptly turned over to the city treasurer to be used in the manner provided for the disposition of fines for traffic violations.

The members of the police department are hereby authorized to refrain from instituting a prosecution for the alleged offense involved. Provided, that this section shall not apply to persons parking a vehicle so as to obstruct the entrance or exit of any place where police or fire apparatus or other-emergency equipment is kept or housed or so as to block an emergency entrance to a hospital. Nor shall this section apply to any person charged with parking a vehicle so as to entirely obstruct traffic in any street or alley, or parking in such a way as to reduce traffic on an arterial street to one-way traffic only; nor to any person who refuses to move a vehicle illegally parked at the request of any member of the police department. (Ord. 0 77 17, 6 7-1977; amd. Ord. 0 98-29, 7-20-1998, eff. 7-30-1998)

SECTION NINE: Title 9, Chapter 3, Section 4 A B. POLICE ALARM SYSTEMS, Service Charges is hereby amended as follows:

9-3-4: SERVICE CHARGES:

A. Imposition Of A Service Charge:

- 1. Excessive Occurrences: More than three (3) alarm occurrences in a calendar year from any alarm system for which an alarm user permit has been obtained shall result in the imposition of service charges according to the schedule in the following subsection: in the amount of \$125 per occurrence.
- 2. Schedule Of Service Charges:

- a. Four (4) to six (6) alarm occurrences in one calendar year: Fifty dollars (\$50.00) per alarm occurrence.
- b. Seven (7) to nine (9) alarm occurrences in one calendar year: One hundred dollars (\$100.00) per alarm occurrence.
- c. Ten (10) or more alarm occurrences in one calendar year: One hundred fifty dollars (\$150.00) per alarm occurrence.
- B. Notice: After the city has recorded three (3) alarm occurrences within a calendar year from any alarm user permit holder, the city shall notify the alarm user, in writing by first class mail or by direct police service, of such fact and of the fact that additional alarm occurrences will result in the imposition of service charges in accordance with the above schedule. Upon additional alarm occurrences, the city shall invoice the alarm user permit holder on a calendar menth basis for the service charge which has been imposed.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval. And publication in pamphlet form and posting as prescribed by law.
